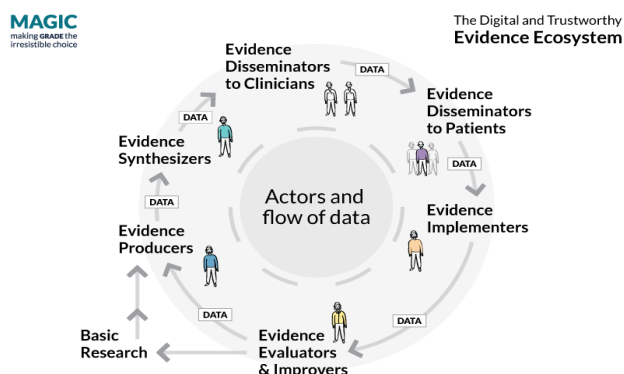

2017 GLOBAL EVIDENCE SUMMIT. 12 TO 16 SEPTEMBER 2017, CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA

The conference brought together more than 1300 people from 75 countries, interested in the fields of health, education, and international development. The summit, with a theme "Using evidence. Improving life." was jointly organised by The Cochrane, The Campbell Collaboration, and some other groups to focus on evidence-based policy making across sectors. Topics included evidence mapping, systematic reviews, rapid reviews, standard and guideline setting, big data, and policy engagement. Presenters used the term 'evidence ecosystem' to denote the circular path of evidence; from study to policy.

EVIDENCE-BASED MEDICINE WORKSHOP. 15 TO 17 DECEMBER 2017, RIJEKA, CROATIA

Naqash Sethi, Christian Gluud, and Janus Jakobsen, from Copenhagen Trial Unit/CHBG were among the trainers at the workshop for about 60 doctors, coming also from places close to Rijeka. The presentations were mostly on methodological issues such as

evidence from observational studies and randomised trials, risk of bias, sample size, heterogeneity, subgroup analyses, and sensitivity analyses of meta-analysis, etc. The workshop was organised by Davor Stimac, CHBG editor, Goran Poropat, Goran Hauser, and Christian Gluud. This workshop is run for a second time.

BEST OF EASL - MOSCOW 23 TO 26 MARCH 2018. XXIII INTERNATIONAL RUSSIAN CONGRESS "HEPATOLOGY TODAY"

Dimitrinka Nikolova and Christian Gluud were invited by the Russian Scientific Liver Society to give presentations on 23 of March. The clinical symposium was chaired by Chavdar Pavlov, and the talks presented were on conductance and publication of Cochrane systematic protocols and reviews (D. Nikolova), examples of Cochrane systematic review of interventions and diagnostic test accuracy studies (C. Pavlov) and evidence-based hepatology (C. Gluud). Lise Lotte Gluud presented a lecture based on the results of a CHBG review on carvedilol and other beta-blockers for treatment of portal hypertension in cirrhotic patients.

Judging from the audience and the feedback received from the congress organizers, the interest towards Cochrane reviews and evidence-based medicine in general was great; over 400 people were listening to our presentations.

We have established new contacts for which we are very happy. We believe that our already established collaboration with the Russian-CHBG research group, led by C Pavlov, Professor at the Clinic of Internal Diseases Propedeutics, I.M. Sechenov First Moscow State Medical University, and Professor at the Kazan Federal University in Kazan, will develop further and will educate more CHBG authors or peer reviewers in Russia. We thank all the organisers for making this event and our stay unforgettable.
